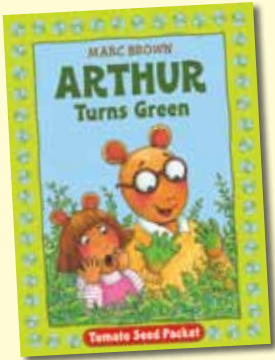


BUSTER AND ARTHUR HELP OUT IN THE GARDEN, PLANTING VEGETABLES THAT THE FAMILY CAN EAT.

You and a grown-up can use the Arthur Turns Green tomato seed packet to plant your very own tomato plant, and in a few weeks your family can enjoy fresh tomatoes!



Things you'll need:

- tomato seed packet
- a large pot
- dirt
- an old wooden ruler or "stake"



1. Find a nice sunny spot where your tomato plant can live. Plants love sun and being in direct sunlight all day will help your tomatoes grow.
2. Fill your pot with dirt about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way. Don't be afraid to get your hands dirty for the planet!
3. Dig a few holes for the tomato seeds. The holes should be about 6 inches deep.
4. Drop a few seeds in each hole and then cover them up with more dirt so that the seeds stay warm.
5. Ever notice that tomatoes are very juicy? That's because they love water! Make sure to give your plant plenty of water, so that the dirt is always moist, but don't give it too much! The dirt should never be too soggy, and never dried out.
6. Tomatoes like to stay active by climbing! It's important to give your tomato plant something to climb up. Stick an old wooden ruler or a tall straight stick into the dirt near the seeds.
7. Water your plant each day, and in a few weeks you'll see tomatoes ready for harvest. What will you make with them?
